

Chiefs Fan Code of Conduct

The Kansas City Chiefs would like to thank all of their fans for making a great atmosphere for our coaches, players and other fans in attendance. Your passion, excitement and support are important to the success of the team. The Chiefs are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for their fans both inside Arrowhead Stadium and throughout our parking areas. When attending a Kansas City Chiefs game, all fans should be aware of and comply with the Code of Conduct.

Stadium and parking lot staff will promptly intervene to support an environment where all event patrons can enjoy the game. Fans attending games are required to refrain from the following behaviors:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures
- Interference with the progress of the game, going onto the field or throwing objects onto the field
- Failing to follow instructions of stadium personnel
- Verbal or physical harassment of opposing team fans
- Smoking except in designated areas
- Obscene or indecent clothing or signs
- Behavior that detracts from the day of game enjoyment of fellow fans; i.e. blocking views
- Attempting to sit in a location other than the guest's ticketed seat
- Conduct that endangers spectators or participants
- Selling items or tickets in stadium or within the sports complex
